

Minutes of the meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Durham held June 24, 2003, at the Town Building in Oak Hill, N.Y.

The Supervisor called the meeting to order at 7:02 P.M. with the Pledge to the Flag. Nineteen people were present.

The application for mass gathering permit was discussed page by page. The following is a list of proposed changes.

1. add drivers license information
2. delete statement of financial resources
3. mass gathering-1000 people at any one time
4. no exception on limits, except for town sponsored events
5. file application 1 month prior to event
6. permit granted or denied within 3 weeks of applying
7. section on water was deleted as it is handled by NYS Health Department
8. correct transportation arrangements to show local, county & state police to be notified and the police to notify the town of a satisfactory plan
9. deleted plan for detailed food service as it is handled by NYS Health Dept.
10. deleted toilet and hand washing facilities as it is handled by NYS Health Dept.
11. deleted water supply facilities as it is handled by NYS Health Dept.
12. changed 48 hours to 72 hours to remove refuse and cleaning of properties
13. detailed emergency first aid plan was discussed
14. no more than 75 decibels between 12 pm and 8 am
15. corrected to show lighting for public areas at events to be held after daylight hours
