

MEETING OF THE DURHAM TOWN BOARD, FEBRUARY 4, 2014

A meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Durham, County of Greene and the State of New York was held at the Town Hall, 7309 State Route 81, East Durham, NY on the 4th, day of February.

OTHERS PRESENT: Joe van Holsteyn-Highway Superintendent, David Cunningham-Building Inspector, Thomas Sutton – Police Sgt., and 5 community members.

Supervisor Carr called the meeting to order 7:30 p.m.

Paul Brown with EvoWorld Biomass Heating Systems gave a presentation on wood chip and wood pellet boilers offered by his company. The board agreed to study the information provided and consider this option.

Action tabled on the Shapanack unsafe building, as Code Enforcement Officer Asaro was not able to attend the meeting.

Highway Superintendent van Holsteyn reported the highway crew is preparing for the anticipated evening storm. The town has used the contracted allotment obtained under the state bid and now needs to secure product on their own. Fortunately, Highway Superintendent van Holsteyn was able to secure additional sand for \$1.50 per ton less than state bid from the same vendor. In addition, he obtained the sand mix at \$1.00 less than we had been paying and the Town of Windham has 1,300 gallons of liquid calcium they need to move and he agreed to accept it at half the market price.

Highway Superintendent van Holsteyn also reported he is reviewing the uniform service contract and feels he will be able to update the jackets with reflective fabric at minimal or no additional cost.
